New Bridge Span To Open Soon

The westbound span of the Tappan Zee Bridge replacement project (the New, New York Bridge) is now undergoing final testing of lighting fixtures, while the eastbound is getting sign structures that will inform motorists of accidents and direct them away from closed lanes. Tappan Zee Constructors also will continue to install structural steel sections and stay cables on the eastbound main span. In late July, the bridge contractor is also planning to undertake overnight paving work near the Rockland landing. Gov. Cuomo let reporters know the westbound span may be in full operation and open on or near Labor Day. Stay tuned.
